Explain why you want to award the work to a particular vendor:

This solicitation was published in the Coloradoan newspaper for three consecutive days (3/30/16 - 4/1/16) and emailed to over 30 vendors located in the COLORADO UCP DBE AND ACDBE DIRECTORY for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) vendors, plus the Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing System emailed it to over 250 of their vendors; however, only one vendor chose to submit a proposal. The Larimer County Purchasing Department reached out to vendors that responded to this solicitation in 2011 trying to better understand what caused the low turnout on this RFP, and responses have been that they are just too busy to take on additional projects at this time.

Each member of the Evaluation Committee individually evaluated and scored the proposal received. The Evaluation Committee unanimously decided to award to Bladeworks, Inc. Bladeworks, Inc.'s services and pricing offered in their proposal was deemed responsible, responsive, reasonable, competitive, and is advantageous to Larimer County.
