

Four (4) proposals were received in response to this Request for Proposal. Adhering to the County's process, each member of the Evaluation Committee individually and independently evaluated and scored each proposal. After reviewing the Scoring Matrix (attached), the Evaluation Team decided to interview Armor Correctional Health Services, Inc., as this vendor garnered the greatest number of "highest" scores per Evaluator. After the interview was complete, the Evaluation Committee unanimously selected Armor Correctional Health Services (pending negotiations), Inc. as they felt their solution was the best fit for the County.
